

The Appointment of the Honourable Mr. Justice Sean Ryan to the Disclosures Tribunal

Following the resolutions of the Dáil of the 13th of November and of the 29th of November, 2018 and following the resolutions of the Seanad of the 14th of November and of the 29th of November, 2018, the Minister for Justice and Equality has, by Instrument dated the 7th of December, 2018, appointed the Honourable Mr. Justice Sean Ryan to be a member of the Disclosures Tribunal established by Instrument dated the 17th of February, 2017. Following upon this the Honourable Mr. Justice Peter Charleton, Judge of the Supreme Court, has determined, on the 11th of December, 2018, pursuant to the Tribunal of Inquiry (Evidence) Acts, 1921 to 2004, that the Honourable Mr. Justice Sean Ryan be Chairperson of a division of the Tribunal to continue and conclude the work of the Tribunal comprised in Term of Reference (p).viz;

Term of Reference (p):

To consider any other complaints by a member of the Garda Síochána who has made a protected disclosure prior to the 16th of February, 2017 alleging wrongdoing within the Garda Síochána where, following the making of the Protected Disclosure, the Garda making the said Protected Disclosure was targeted or discredited with the knowledge or acquiescence of senior members of the Garda Síochána.

The Chairperson, the Honourable Mr. Justice Peter Charleton, Judge of the Supreme Court, has also determined, with effect from the 11th of December 2018, that Mr. Justice Sean Ryan has, in accordance therewith, all and every function necessary to continue and conclude the work comprised in Term of Reference (p).
